

CENTRAL BROOKLYN COMMUNITY SUPPORTED AGRICULTURE (CBCSA)



A CSA is a great way to support a local farm while getting fresh, delicious produce!

In order to participate, members sign up and pay for a season's worth of vegetables up front. Members can also add on extras like eggs, fruit, and flowers. Then, members pick up their shares on a weekly or biweekly schedule.

By paying up front, members ensure that local farmers have funds to support their staff and farm needs throughout their season. The farmers plan to get a robust crop for us every year, but as nature is unpredictable, the quantity and type of vegetables will vary depending on how the season goes for the farm.

The price of a share varies based on your income. We also accept SNAP.

The summer season is June through October, and the winter season is November through February (monthly pickups). Sign-ups generally close 1-2 weeks before the season starts. If we are in the middle of a season, we cannot sign up new members, but please ask a volunteer about signing up for our newsletter or waitlist. We would love to have you join us for next season!
